

**Town of Arcola**

**Bylaw No. 2018-05**

**A Bylaw to Provide for the Control and Regulation of Smoking in the Town of Arcola**

---

**The Council of the Town of Arcola, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:**

1. In this Bylaw,
  - a. "Town" means the Town of Arcola;
  - b. "Smoke or Smoking" means and includes the carrying of a lighted cigar, cigarette, pipe or any other lighted smoking equipment;
  - c. "Smokeless Tobacco" means and includes any form of chewing tobacco or snuff;
  - d. "Town Buildings" means and includes the Town Office, Library, the Public Works Shop, Prairie Place Complex, the Water Treatment Plant, the fire hall, all sewer lift stations, and any other facilities acquired or owned by the Town of Arcola;
  - e. "Town Vehicles" means and includes all Town-owned vehicles and equipment, licensed or unlicensed.
2. No person shall smoke or use smokeless tobacco in and around any town buildings or town vehicles at any time.
3. No person shall smoke within three meters of any exit or entrance door in and around any town buildings.
4. Signs are hereby authorized to be posted in and around the town buildings and town vehicles as deemed appropriate to inform members of the public and staff of any provisions of this bylaw.
5. Any person who contravenes any provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable to a penalty of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).
6. Where a person has committed or is alleged to have committed a breach of any provision of this bylaw, a ticket may be served on such person by the Bylaw Enforcement Officer, or the Chief Administrative Officer. If payment is received or postmarked within ten (10) calendar days of the issue date, the Town will reduce the required payment to a sum of Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00), and the person will not be liable to further court action.
7. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the final passing thereof.
