Bylaw No. 2018-06

A Bylaw to Restrict the Use and Consumption of Water in the Town of Arcola

The Council of the Town of Arcola, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as “The Water Restriction Bylaw”.
2. All consumers are prohibited from wasting water. Wasting of water includes:
 - i. broken or malfunctioning underground sprinklers,
 - ii. placement of sprinklers and lawn watering devices such that they spray water onto hard surfaces such as driveways, sidewalks, patios and streets,
 - iii. manually operated sprinklers and lawn watering devices that are left on for more than 60 minutes,
 - iv. watering an area for more than 60 minutes,
 - v. washing of driveways and private walkways.
3. Hours for outside watering shall be 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.
4. Odd numbered addresses shall be allowed to use water for outdoor purposes on odd numbered calendar days.
5. Even numbered addresses shall be allowed to use water for outdoor purposes on even numbered calendar days.
6. The filling of hot tubs and swimming pools from the Town’s water system is not permitted.
7. Further restrictions may be implemented by resolution of Council, in the event of emergency or water plant capacity issues.
8. a. First infraction of the provisions of this Bylaw shall be subject to a fine of one hundred dollars (\$100.00).
b. Second and subsequent infractions of the provisions of this Bylaw shall be subject to a fine of two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00), and termination of water service. A re-connection fee of \$100.00 shall be paid prior to reinstatement of service.
9. This Bylaw shall be in effect from June 1st to September 30th of each year, unless otherwise amended.
10. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of final passing thereof.
