## Bylaw No. 2018-09

## A Bylaw to Provide for the Numbering of Houses and other Buildings in the **Town of Arcola**

The Council of the Town of Arcola, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw shall be referred to as the "Civic Addressing Bylaw".
- 2. A uniform system of numbering houses and other buildings is hereby established and is shown on the attached map identified as "Schedule A", appended hereto and forming a part of this bylaw.
- 3. A separate number shall be assigned for each lot.
- 4. Each house or building shall bear the number assigned to the frontage on which the front entrance is situated.
- 5. Notwithstanding section 4 of this bylaw, upon request of the owner of a property situated on a corner, the number assigned may be specific to the flankage.
- 6. In case a house or building is occupied by more than one family dwelling unit or business, each separate front entrance of said house or building shall bear the same number extended with a letter of the alphabet beginning with the letter "A" and proceeding with as many as are required.
- 7. Numerals indicating the official number of each house or building or each front entrance shall be posted in a manner as to be visible from the street on which the property is located.
- 8. The Administrator shall be responsible for maintaining the numbering system and shall keep a record of all numbers assigned under this bylaw.
- 9. Any person who contravenes the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and upon conviction shall be liable on summary conviction to a penalty of \$100.00.
- 10. Bylaw No. 1/87 is hereby repealed.
