SAMA appraisers will be in your community beginning on the date listed above.

Over time, property assessments become dated because of changes to the property and gradual wear and tear, that are not identified through an annual maintenance review. The General undertakes to Reinspection Program review each property to re- establish a uniform base of up-to-date property records for the municipality.

Any assessment changes as a result of the reinspection will be effective for January 1, 2025.

SAMA's goal, starting in 2018, is to reinspect every property in the province on a 12-year cycle.

2024 Budget Updates

The Council of the Town of Arcola has approved the budget for 2024 and set this year's mill rate at 6 %. This year's discounts are as follows; a 6% discount will be applied to payments received by the end of July; and 3% for payment received by the end of August.

Taxes are to be paid in full by December 31, 2024. Remember if you are mailing your taxes to get your cheque in the mail early so it arrives on time.

A 5% penalty will be added on January 1st to any outstanding taxes; an additional 5% penalty will be added to taxes still outstanding on February 1st.
