2025 Budget Updates

The Council of the Town of Arcola has approved the budget for 2025 and set this year's mill rate at 6.25 %. This year's discounts are as follows; a 6% discount will be applied to payments received by the end of July; and 3% for payment received by the end of August.

Taxes are to be paid in full by December 31, 2025. Remember if you are mailing your taxes to get your cheque in the mail early so it arrives on time.

A 5% penalty will be added on January 1st to any outstanding taxes; an additional 5% penalty will be added to taxes still outstanding on February 1st.
